*Allan Powell is an architect whose practice has, over 33 years, made an outstanding contribution to the design quality and style of Melbourne residential, commercial and educational buildings.*

*After graduating from The University of Melbourne, Powell worked with the office of Guilford Bell for 5 years, learning the disciplined approach to planning and constructing his elegant and minimalist houses. He has, with his work, inspired successive generations of Melbourne architecture students.*

*In 1976, Powell established his own practice, producing numerous residential projects, mainly in metropolitan Melbourne, a range of restaurant and hotel projects, which set the design style for Melbourne fine dining, and, in association with other practices, award winning buildings for RMIT and Monash Universities and the Tarrawarra Art Gallery in the Yarra Valley.*

*Powell's completed projects have been published widely in the Institute and Australian design journals, guide books and architectural publications.*

*Powell has been regularly premiated in Chapter Awards for residential, commercial and educational projects for design, interiors and urban design categories and also in the Dulux Colour and Belle House of the Year Awards.*

*Powell completed his Master Degree at RMIT University in 1992, and has been a Design Tutor at The University of Melbourne and visiting critic and examiner at RMIT University.*
