Carey Lyon is known for his distinguished career as an architect, a lecturer, a mentor, a writer, an awards winner and jury member and a competition participant and judge.

His most recent contribution to the architectural profession as the RAlA National President 2006-07 has been exemplary.

Carey has worked and studied in Australia and overseas and has lectured extensively at universities nationally and internationally.

He has been a director of the high-profile Melbourne architectural practice 'Lyons', for 10 years.

This practice has won significant design competitions across Australia and has received a large number of national and state architectural awards, including the Victorian Architecture Medal.

In 2005, he had been a National Councillor for three years prior to accepting the office of President Elect.

As National President he has championed and written about many significant issues facing the profession, using the media of 'Architecture Australia', RAlA Memo and RAlA e-news.

Early in his term as President, Carey invited architects to contribute short essays on 'why architecture matters' to 'Architecture Australia' and expressed interest in receiving communications from members.

As is Carey's personal style, he regularly acknowledges and thanks the many dedicated members who contribute to the RAlA in a volunteer capacity.

Throughout his career, Carey has demonstrated a willingness to contribute to the architectural profession and provides generous support to younger members of the profession.

He has had two terms as an RAlA Victoria Council member, from 1992 to 1995 and from 2000 to 2003.

Carey's vision for the RAlA and its future direction continues to inspire and enthuse RAlA members.
