Anthony Mussen has made an outstanding contribution to the practice of architecture at many levels and in many spheres of practice.

As a practicing architect he has contributed for over 30 years to the built environment in a signature practice and then in private practice to the present time.

As an educator, he has been the co-ordinator of practice subjects at the University of Melbourne and then Deputy Head of the Department of Architecture and Building; the Deputy Head of Faculty and Head of Architecture, the Deputy Dean and most recently Associate Dean.

He is a respected Expert Witness, with many appearances in front of Panels, specialising in a range of issues relating to construction, architectural practice and copyright.

As Practice Director of the Victorian Chapter of the RAILA: author of Practice Manuals and Guidelines, he has contributed to the way Australian architectural practices operate: as a member of the Architect's Registration Board of Victoria and as Chair of Tribunals he has made a significant impact on the way individual architects practice.

He has been an exemplary model of an architect in the spheres of architectural practice, education and community participation.
